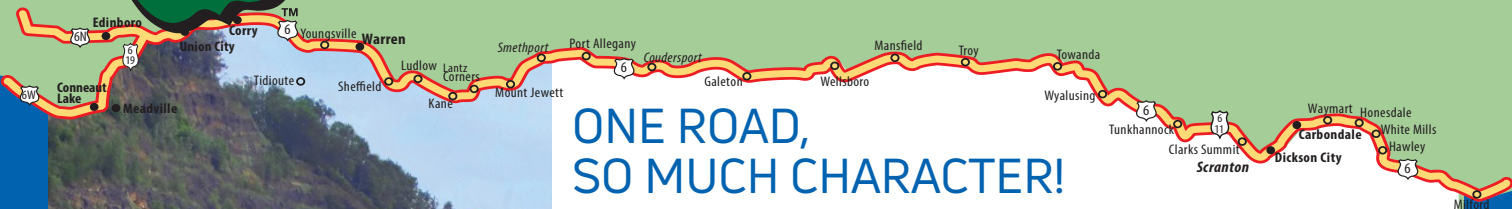

Travel all 427 miles of US Route 6 across Northern Pennsylvania, you will encounter diverse natural resources and heritage themes telling an extraordinary multilayered story of the PA Route 6 Heritage Corridor.

More than just a scenic road trip through the rural countryside, PA Route 6 takes you on a journey through seven unique **Character Areas**, each named for its primary natural or historic resource. While each can be considered the corridor's top destination for its resource, all seven resources can also be found throughout the entire corridor, making PA Route 6 your road to an extensive array of landscapes, activities, and stories.

Let's "Do 6" from Mile Marker (MM) 0 in the west to MM 400 in the east, stopping in the **Character Areas** along the way to explore **Spotlight Attractions** and **More Across the Corridor**. Use the MM numbers throughout the guide and corresponding "Do 6" Mile Marker Signs along the highway to plan your travels. Now, buckle up — it's going to be a fun-filled road trip!

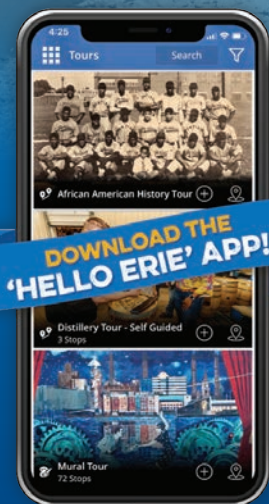

The western end of the corridor promises double the fun with US-6 from Crawford County meeting 6N in Erie County. With Lake Erie, many smaller lakes, and charming lakeside communities, this area showcases the important natural, scenic, and recreational opportunities lakes provide locals and visitors alike.



SPOTLIGHT ATTRACTIONS

Lake Erie & Presque Isle (MM 18N)

Swim, surf, sail, sunset cruise, or fish for walleye in the warmest of the Great Lakes featuring a 3200-acre State Park, historic lighthouses, Environmental Center, and Maritime Museum with reconstructed flagship from the War of 1812.



Pymatuning Spillway & Reservoir (MM 7)

Visit PA's largest manmade lake for all kinds of water fun, including feeding the fish at the Spillway where they are so plentiful "the ducks walk on the fishes' backs" to steal their snacks.



Conneaut Lake's Historic Boardwalk (MM 13)

Stroll the boardwalk of the state's largest natural glacier lake where the family-friendly resort atmosphere of the 1890s is still going strong.



Edinboro Lake (MM 22)

Visit this lake community's many parks, playgrounds, wooded trails, golf courses, and impressive Edinboro University architecture.

Continue east through Crawford, Erie, and Warren Counties and visit the Heritage Communities of Union City, Corry, Youngsville, and Warren. From wooden chairs to corsets and oil to rail cars, these former commercial centers reveal a heritage of hard work and innovation that helped fuel our nation's Industrial Revolution.



SPOTLIGHT ATTRACTIONS

Union City Historic District & Museum (MM 53)

Stroll through this National Historic District and museum for a look into this town's past as "chair capital of the world" thanks to the prolific U.C. Chair Company and regional lumber industry.

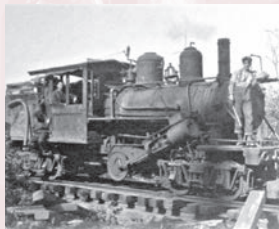


Drake Well Museum & Park (MM 53)

Step onto the site of the first commercial oil well, drilled in 1859, that sparked our modern-day oil industry. Explore operational exhibits, historical equipment, plus a park with trails.

Corry Area Historical Society Museum (MM 65)

Visit the "birthplace of the Climax Locomotive" where volunteers maintain a museum and restoration projects to preserve and share the community's historic impact on industry and rail transportation.



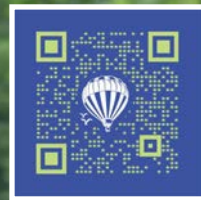
Johnson-Shaw Stereoscope Museum (MM 25)

Experience an "adventure in 3-dimensional photographic history" in the hometown of the Keystone View Company, the largest producer of stereographic materials in the U.S.

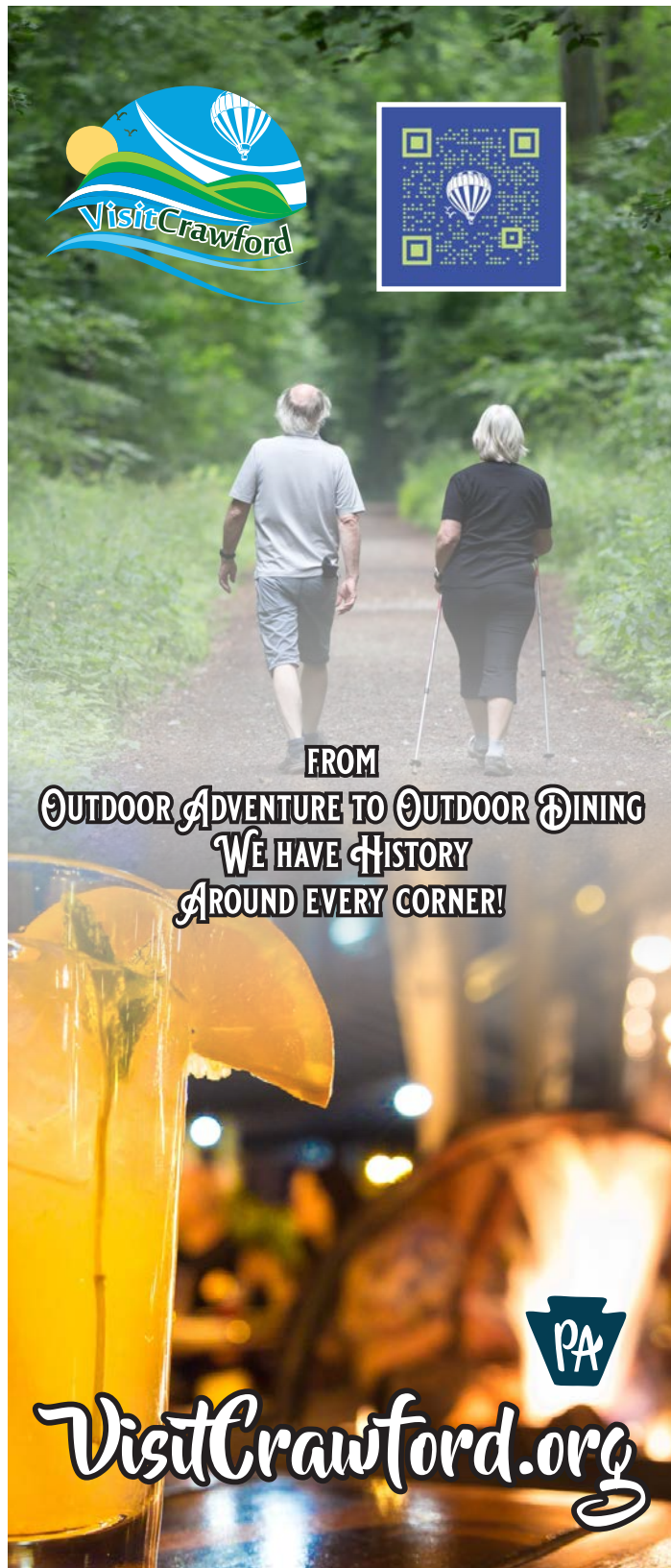

With a National Forest and many State Forests, this Character Area is the largest of all. Follow 6 east through Warren, McKean, Potter, and Tioga Counties full of forest-covered hills, canopies of foliage, abundant wildlife, and communities rooted in lumber heritage.

Allegheny National Forest (MM 86-136)

Plan extra time in the state's only National Forest, home to 600+ miles of trails for public recreation like hiking, biking, mountain biking, cross-country skiing, ATVing, snowmobiling, and more!

Kinzua Bridge State Park & Visitors Center (MM 136)

Enjoy forestland picnic areas, hiking trails, and the Kinzua Sky Walk, fashioned from the wreckage of the historic Viaduct after a 2003 tornado. Inside the Visitors Center, find interactive exhibits on its unique history and the 3 E's: Engineering, Energy, and Environment.

Pennsylvania Lumber Museum (MM 187)

Discover the courageous and sometimes reckless spirit of Pennsylvania's lumber heritage at this museum nestled amidst the forest-filled PA Wilds.

Lyman Run State Park (MM 198)

Find peace and serenity amidst the northern hardwood maple and cherry trees of the Susquehannock State Forest at this 595-acre State Park and Lake named for Potter County's founder and owner of the region's first sawmill.

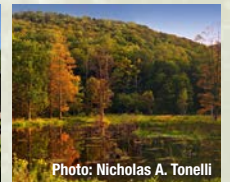

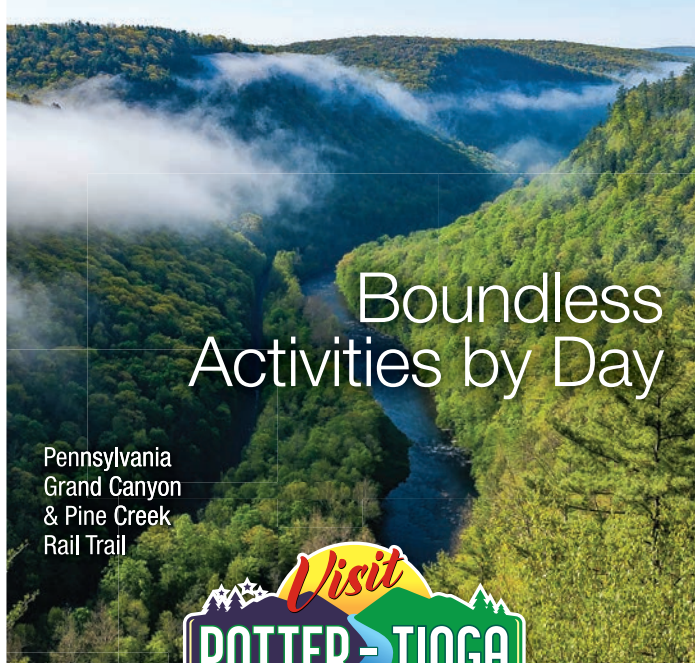

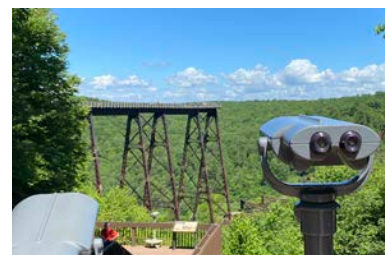

AGRICULTURE

Travel east through Tioga and Bradford Counties and forests diffuse into rolling fields. Rural

communities full of family farms, markets, cider mills, wineries, and farm-to-table dining are the harvest of agricultural heritage planted long ago by indigenous people, early settlers, and generations of farmers.

The History Center on Main Street (MM 234)

Visit one of the oldest buildings and churches in town, now a museum full of artifacts telling the history and genealogy of the region's families and rural communities.

The Heritage Village & Farm Museum (MM 252)

Step back in time to Bradford County's agricultural past at this living history museum with a former stagecoach stop, blacksmith shop, maple sugar shack, general store, antique machinery, and more!



Quilted Corners of Wyalusing (MM 245-294)

Grab a brochure at the Chamber Office downtown, then follow the colorful "barn quilts" on historic barns, churches, businesses, and houses for a scenic drive through the surrounding countryside.

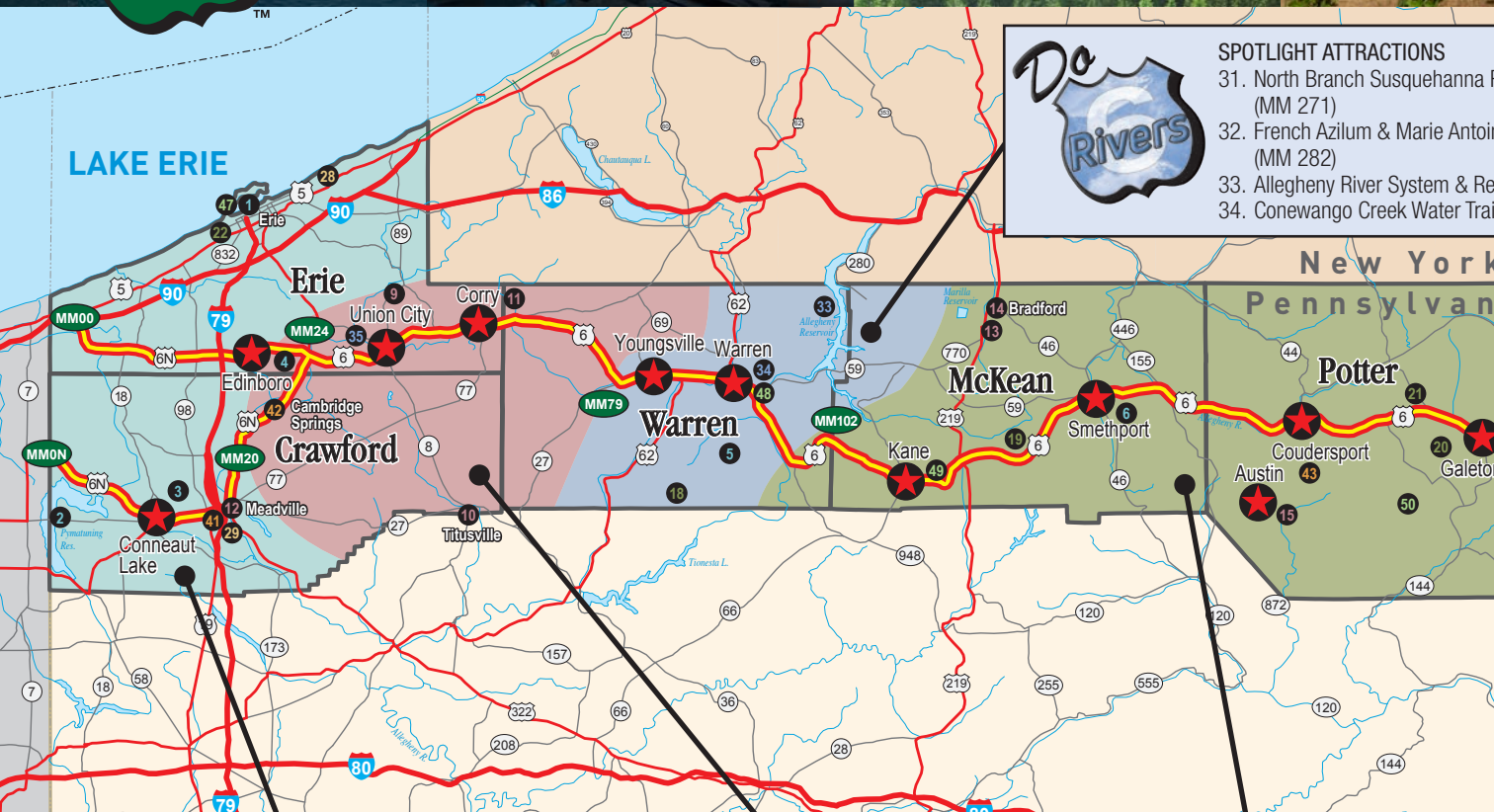

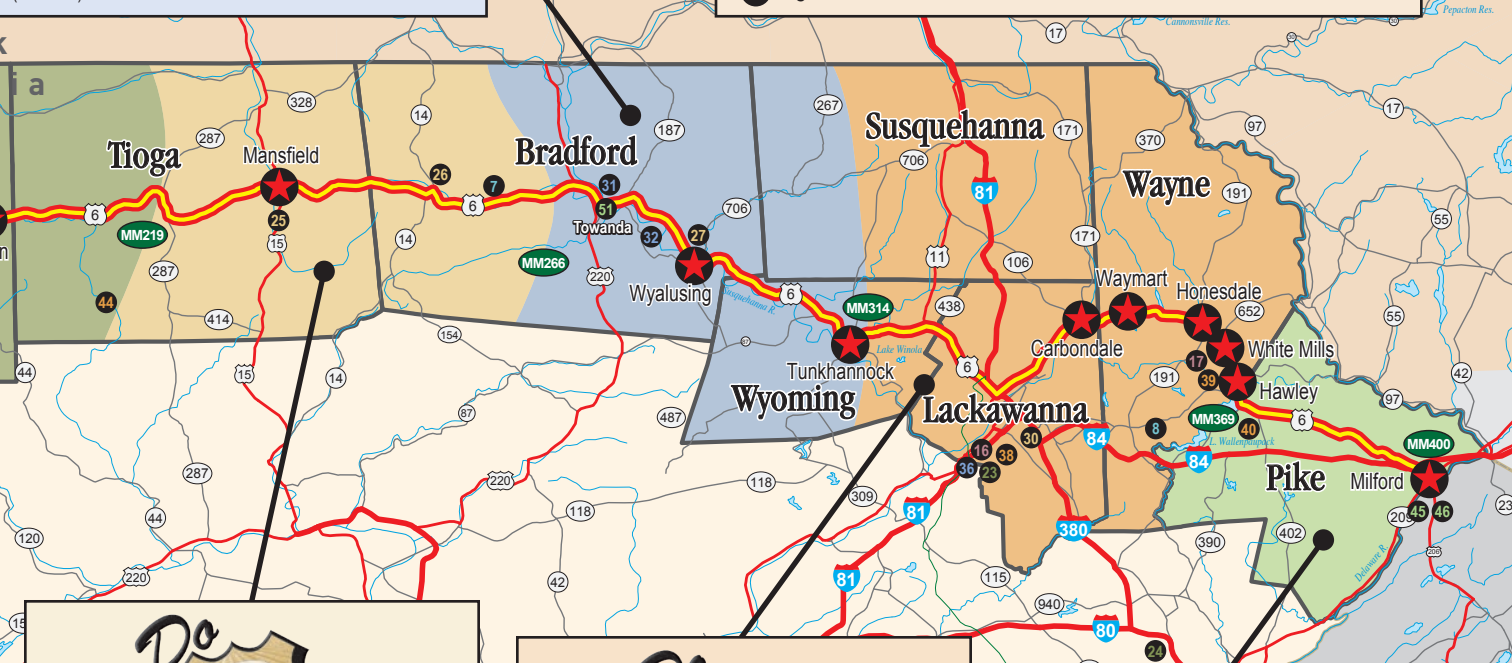

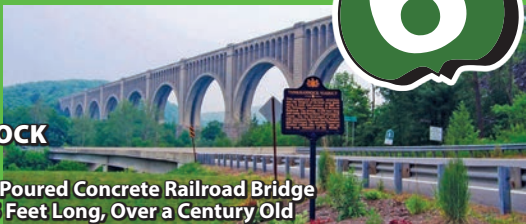

Continue through Bradford and Wyoming Counties for some of the best views and historical sites on 6, all centered around one important natural resource: the Susquehanna River. As sources of drinking water, fertile land, and transportation, the Corridor's rivers and tributaries, including the Susquehanna and its western ally, the Allegheny River, hold secrets of early civilization, indigenous people, and immigrant settlers.

SPOTLIGHT ATTRACTIONS**North Branch Susquehanna River Water Trail (MM 271)**

Kayak, paddle, or fish a river once used by the indigenous Susquehannock Tribe, now recognized as a National Recreation Trail.

French Azilum & Marie Antoinette Lookout (MM 282)

Explore this historic site along the Susquehanna that was at one time a settlement for exiles of the French Revolution, including plans for the Queen herself.

**Allegheny River System & Reservoir (MM 96)**

Outdoor recreation options are boundless on PA's 2017 River of the Year and 12,000-acre reservoir, both surrounded by the gorgeous Allegheny National Forest.

Conewango Creek Water Trail (MM 96)

Paddle back in time on PA's 2015 River of the Year, once an important path for the Seneca Nation, later used as a "logging highway", and now home to 19 native freshwater mussel species and abundant wildlife.

TRANSPORTATION

Traveling on to Pike and Wayne Counties, discover remnants

of the area's critical role in transportation history. Whether by bridge, canal, highway, or rail, transportation heritage landmarks here and across the Corridor transport you to a time when life may have been slower but was no less exciting.

Steamtown National Historic Site (MM 332)

Immerse yourself in railroad history at this preserved rail yard and steam-era complex with a working roundhouse, repair shops, train rides, and various museums, including the Electric City Trolley Museum.

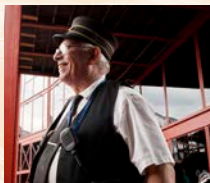
Wayne County Historical Society (MM 358)

See a full-size replica of the first steam locomotive run on U.S. rails, the Stourbridge Lion, in the very community that hosted the historic event. Then, board the Stourbridge Lion for a historical train ride of your own.



D&H Canal Park at Lock 31 (MM 366)

Walk the towpath of the historic Canal, a civil engineering feat built in the 1820s to transport anthracite coal from PA mines to NY's Hudson River.

Round out your road trip in Pike County amidst a couple of the Corridor's natural treasures, the Pocono Mountains and Delaware Water Gap. This area's natural and historic resources have inspired a culture of conservation and preservation across the entire PA Route 6 Heritage Corridor.

SPOTLIGHT ATTRACTIONS

Grey Towers National Historic Site (MM 394)

Visit this picturesque National Historic Site, home of the Pinchot Institute of Conservation Studies, on the former estate of Gifford Pinchot, the 1st Chief of the U.S. Forest Service, considered "Father of American Conservation".



The Columns Museum (MM 394)

Explore this beautifully preserved Neoclassical mansion now home to the Historical Society's Museum full of fascinating artifacts like the famous bloodstained "Lincoln Flag."

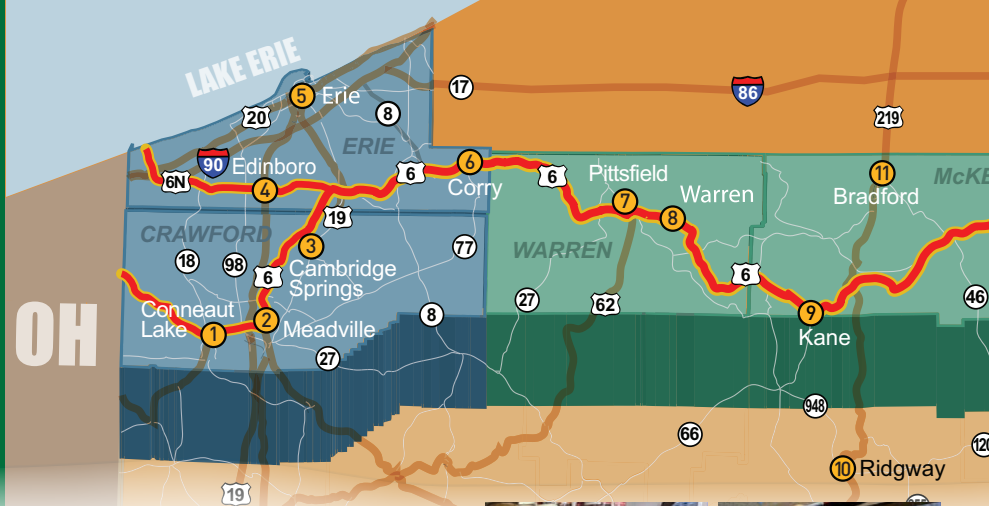

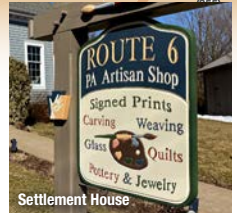
