This is a 4-day, extended weekend itinerary from the central part of Route 6, accessible by Rt. 15 from the north or south, headed east to the New York/ New Jersey border.

Just to the west of the Route 15 / 6 interchange is Wellsboro, which is can also be explored if you have extra time.



Day 1: Mile Markers 234 to 311

First stop is the college town of **Mansfield**. After your long journey to Route 6, be sure to grab a bite at any of Mansfield's fine eating establishments or its cider mill press. Head to Troy and visit the Farm Museum for a look at rural life in Pennsylvania. Get out of the car in **Towanda** and stroll down the riverwalk. Don't miss the scenic views of the Susquehanna River from the **Marie Antoinette & Wyalusing Rocks overlooks**. Then venture off the highway to explore **French Azilum**. Be sure to visit Wyalusing's many antique and specialty shops before ending your evening in **Tunkhannock**, where you can visit artisan galleries and follow the walking tour.

Day 2: Mile Markers 311 to 332

After starting your day by traveling just a little north on Rt. 11 to find the **Tunkhannock Viaduct**, return to Route 6 and make your way into Scranton. There is so much to explore in this city including **Steamtown National Park Site**, **Electric City Trolley Museum**, the **Lackawanna Coal Mine Tour**. You may even want to spend your afternoon taking a train excursion through the colorful mountains. Stay in one of the many accommodation in Scranton and test the varied European fare. Many cultural events happen in this city, be sure to take one in.

Day 3 Mile Markers 332 to 369

In the morning, drive to **Honesdale**, where you can learn more about the steam locomotive at the **Wayne County Historical Society**. Visit **Dorflinger Glass Museum & Wildlife Sanctuary** in White Mills Explore Hawley, where you can spend a few hours relaxing by **Lake Wallenpaupack**. Fishing, boating and other water sports are available. A variety of overnight accommodations are available in Hawley.

Day 4: Mile Markers 369 to 400

Hike into **Shohola Falls**. Spend the day in **Milford**, named one of the state's "Prettiest Painted Places". Explore **Grey Towers**, the **Column's Museum** and the town's many unique shops. Or get back to nature by hiking, biking, swimming, or canoeing in the Upper Delaware National Recreational Area.
