

Take THE High Road - Scenic PA Route 6

PA Wilds West Loop

Allegheny National Forest



Start your PA Wilds West Loop in the City of Bradford by visiting the *Allegheny National Forest Visitors Bureau Welcome Center* for maps, and information on nearby attractions and lodging(4). Spend the day touring the world famous Zippo/Case Museum & Flagship Store (5) and Penn Brad Oil Museums. A self-guided walking tour in Bradford's National Historic District takes you past family owned restaurants and quaint shops. Best Western PLUS Bradford Inn is conveniently located within walking distance of downtown. Head west along Rt. 346, then turn south on Rt. 321 for beautiful views of the deep and lush Allegheny National Forest. Merge with Rt. 59 W and travel along the Longhouse National Scenic Byway. Capture a fantastic view of the Allegheny Reservoir by taking a side road and stopping at Rimrock Overlook. Return to Rt. 59 W, travel the bridge across the Reservoir and stop at Kinzua Point and Kinzua Dam for spectacular views.

Turn right onto Rt. 6 towards Warren, follow the Bus. Rt. 6 signs to the downtown. The self-guided Walkable Warren Tour, features a parade of grand homes and scenes along the Allegheny River. Enjoy eating at local restaurants and exploring the Blair Store and Museum or shopping at Warren Antiques and Giftware(6).

Take Market Street (Rt. 62 N) to Russell, passing The Commons shopping plaza along the way. Head west on Rt. 957 through Amish Country to Sugar Grove. Then follow Rt. 958 to Rt. 6 East, traveling towards Youngsville and Irvine. Make a stop at the Wilder Museum on Erie Avenue. Continue on Rt. 6 E with a stop at the Warren County Visitors Bureau (7), for friendly assistance and information. Capture a picture with the replica of the iconic Gateway Arch to keep as a souvenir. Continue on Rt. 6 E., stop at Main Street Artisans in Sheffield for a unique shopping experience. Enjoy steak and seafood at Table 105(8). Taste and tour at CJ Spirits Distillery(9) or Logyard Brewing(10). Drive east on Rt. 6 E to Mt. Jewett before turning left onto the Kinzua Bridge Scenic Byway to the Kinzua Sky Walk and the Kinzua Bridge Visitors Center.

Return to Rt. 6, turn left to head east to the Victorian town of Smethport. Enjoy an overnight stay in Smethport. Follow the self-guided Smethport Mansion District Walking Tour and grab a bite to eat at Corner Bistro. Start the morning traveling through the beautiful scenery of farmlands and forest to arrive in Port Allegheny. Rt. 6 will make a right turn, from there go to the second stop light to tour Serenity Glass Park, which features brilliant architectural displays in shimmering glass. Driving from Port Allegheny, drive west on Rt. 6 to the end of Port Allegheny, then continue straight to Rt. 155. Take Rt. 155 to Rt. 446 N to Eldred. Stop and tour the Eldred World War II Museum(12), a world class museum with history you can see, touch and feel. From Rt. 446 N, turn onto 346 W to Bradford for the night. In the morning you will have access to Rt. 219, which leads to Niagara Falls, Canada or South Western PA possibly your next "wild" journey.
